Physico-chemistry of Cultural Heritage materials and objects using vibrational spectroscopy

Project Description

Research focuses on ancient materials and objects to develop analytical strategies combining Raman and infrared spectroscopies with X-ray fluorescence for structural and elemental analysis. These approaches can address both archaeological/historical issues (archaeometry), as well as questions in conservation science. The main challenges are to develop essentially non-invasive/destructive analytical strategies, from archaeological/conservation sites (using mobile measurements) to the laboratory.
