Remote sensing and land degradation in the Sahel region

Project Description

Sahelian land degradation raises scientific debate for decades now. After the 1980s drought, regional regreening was observed based on remote sensing. Yet, the mechanisms behind it, like the link between vegetation growth and rainfall, or the plant diversity changes, and their potential human causes remain unclear. You will improve our estimation of land degradation in the Senegalese Sahel, relying on latest satellite observations and literature, exchanges with local partners, and field surveys.
