Well-being assessment through wastewater based epidemiology, a comparative study

Project Description

This post-doctoral project is part of a wider project to use wastewater to assess health and well-being in socio-economically contrasting populations in the Paris region. The aim is to analyze chemical tracers (targeted and non-targeted analyses) to assess overall practices and the exposome of targeted populations, before identifying the main determinants of well-being. One of the objectives is to build, with colleagues in social sciences and link with local stakeholders, a well-being indicator.
