### Project Title

Pre- and post-consumption organic waste recycling : health aid or health hazard?

### Project Description

Much work has looked at pre-consumption waste management, less work has examined how post-consumption (e.g. excreta) waste can be valorised. Before any large scale process can be setup, it is necessary to evaluate the potential impacts on human health as well as the social acceptability of such measures. This project will examine this question in tropical ecosystems where access to water and economic constraints render the recycling of post-consumption waste an interesting economic option.
